1.What level of CPR certification should I have?

As a health care provider you should be taking/renewing CPR LEVEL C with AED

2. How often do I have to renew my CPR certification?

<u>Section 73(3)</u> of the College Bylaws states that "Full registrants must complete a CPR certification course at least once every three years and must hold a certification that is no more than three years old when renewing their registration under section 63".

3.Do I need to report my CPR certification to the College?

Please self-report/self-record your CPR certification on your College profile, under 'Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certification'. This can be done by logging on to your College profile under <u>Registrant Login</u>, selecting 'View My Profile', and scrolling to the bottom of the page. Click 'edit' and proceed to input your CPR certification and expiry dates.
