Policy Statement:

A Registrant of the Designated Health Profession of Occupational Therapy (a "Registrant") who does not maintain their registration in good standing will have their registration revoked.

Good standing is maintained by ensuring that all required registration renewal documentation is provided to the College by the renewal deadline and that payment of all fees — and penalties, if required — has been received.

Notification

A Registrant will be notified in writing of a pending revocation of their registration, at which point they will have 14 days to bring their registration into good standing.

If registration is revoked, the Registrant will be notified in writing, by registered mail. The conditions for reinstatement will be provided.
