Policy Statement:

A Full or Temporary Registrant of the Designated Health Profession of Physical Therapy (a "Registrant") must maintain individual professional liability insurance in an amount of at least \$3,000,000 per occurrence.

1. Policy Rationale and Purpose:

Historically, Registrants may have been covered by their employers' professional liability insurance (PLI) policies and/or by their own individual policies. This policy clarifies that each Registrant must have an individual PLI policy, which will ensure that the public is covered for their Physical Therapy practice, regardless of where it takes place.

2. Policy Scope:

This policy applies to all Full and Temporary Registrants of the Designated Health Profession of Physical Therapy. A Student Registrant is exempt if covered by their academic program's PLI.

Individual PLI policy – A professional liability insurance policy taken out by the Registrant in their own name; does not include an employer's policy, even if the Registrant is named therein
