Registrant: This public notification has been anonymized as required by section 39.3(4) of the *Health Professions Act*, on the basis of an admission by the Registrant that they suffer from a health condition that impairs their ability to practise.

Date: November 28, 2019

Status: In Effect

Nature of Action: The Registrant agreed to undertakings under section 36(1) of the *Health Professions Act* restricting them from conducting psychological assessments and confirming their agreement to take appropriate steps to manage their ongoing therapy practice to address the potential impact of their health condition.

Reason: The Registrant's agreement resolved an investigation initiated by the Inquiry Committee on its own motion under section 33(4) of the *Health Professions Act* into concerns about the Registrant's competence to perform psychological assessments generally. In the course of the investigation, the Registrant voluntarily took steps to address identified concerns arising from a review of particular assessment files, and the Registrant agreed to discontinue her assessment practice. The Inquiry Committee was satisfied that the public would be protected by a broad restriction on the Registrant's future practice, together with agreed measures to accommodate the Registrant's admitted health condition to protect against its potential impact on therapy clients.
