



PUBLIC NOTICE

Nature of Action:

On October 27, 2023, the Registrar of the College of Speech and Hearing Health Professionals of BC (“CSHBC”) received a complaint concerning the Licensee (the “Complaint”). On June 28, 2024, the CSHBC amalgamated with six other health colleges to form the College of Health and Care Professionals of British Columbia (the “College”). A panel of the College’s Inquiry Committee (the “Panel”) investigated the Complaint pursuant to section 33(1) of the *Health Professions Act* (the “Act”).

Action:

On March 31, 2026, the Licensee voluntarily entered into a consent and undertaking agreement (the “Agreement”) pursuant to section 33(6)(c) and 36(1) of the Act, in which she:

1. Consents and undertakes not to independently engage in dysphagia practice until she has successfully completed a period of supervision in this area of practice.
2. Consents and undertakes not to independently engage in communication practice until she has successfully completed a period of supervision in this area of practice.

The Panel determined this to be a serious matter under s. 39.3 of the Act requiring publication.

Reasons for the Action:

The Panel approved the Agreement in order to address its concerns regarding the standard of the Licensee’s dysphagia practice. The Panel also had concerns about the standard of clinical documentation in the Licensee’s dysphagia and communication practice. The Panel is satisfied that the terms of the Agreement will support the Licensee to develop her skills and confidence in the areas where issues were identified while also serving to protect the public from harm.
