Limits and Conditions under section 52 of the *Health Professions and Occupations Act, SBC 2022, c 43* (the “HPOA”)

Licensee: Scott McKee

Effective Date: May 13, 2026

1. The Licensee’s practice is restricted to employment with School District 23 and they must inform the College of any change, or anticipated change, in their current employment.
2. The Licensee’s practice is restricted to behavioural screening using the Behaviour Assessment System for Children (“BASC”), specifically:
 - a. Identifying themselves to parents / guardians and obtaining informed consent for assessment;
 - b. Reviewing student school records and collateral information;
 - c. Administering and scoring BASC assessments;
 - d. Preparing written behavioural screening reports using a standardized format; and
 - e. Participating in feedback meetings to review the contents of written behavioural screening reports with parents / guardians in the presence of school personnel.
3. The Licensee must comply with any additional limits or restrictions placed on their provision of psychological services by School District 23, and must inform the College of any change, or anticipated change, in School District 23’s BASC Administration Process framework.
4. The Licensee must, on the last business day of each month, provide the College with written confirmation that their practice remains in accordance with the limits and conditions on their licence.
