Notice of Order

On June 5, 2026, the Deputy Registrar of the College of Health and Care Professionals of BC (“College”) made the Disciplinary Order (“Order”) set out below relating to the Respondent.

Reasons for Order

On January 27, 2025, the College received a report (“Report”) under s. 32.2 of the *Health Professions Act* about the Respondent. Following an investigation, the Investigation Committee (“Committee”) assessed the allegations raised in the Report. The Committee found that it had reasonable grounds to believe that the Respondent lacked competence and/or had committed acts of misconduct. In particular, the Committee found that the Respondent had:

- Failed to maintain appropriate professional boundaries
- Failed to maintain accurate and complete clinical records
- Failed to practice in a safe and competent manner
- Failed to collaborate with colleagues

The Panel determined that it would be appropriate to dispose of the concerns identified by directing the Deputy Registrar to make the Order set out below with the Respondent’s consent under s. 158(2)(b) and s. 269(d)(iii) of the *Health Professions and Occupations Act*.

The Order was consented to and signed by the Respondent on May 29, 2026.

Order

Pursuant to the Decision of the Investigation Committee dated April 29, 2026, the Deputy Registrar hereby disposes of the Complaint by making the following order:

A disciplinary order that requires the Respondent, on or before a specified date, to undertake specified education, training or other remedial activities as set out below (HPOA s. 269(d)(iii)).

Particulars

Specified Education, Training or Other Remedial Activities

1. On or before November 30, 2026, the Respondent will:
 - a. complete the PROBE Course on Ethics and Professional boundaries, at his own expense;
 - b. complete the Write Stuff e-learning module;
 - c. Review the current Code of Ethics and Practice Standards; and
 - d. Participate in an audit of his clinical records (“Clinical Records Audit”) to verify compliance with the current Records standard, at his own expense.
2. The Respondent will provide evidence of his successful completion of the courses set out at 1(a) and 1(b) above to the College within two weeks of receiving the same.
3. The Respondent will provide confirmation of his review of the current Code of Ethics and Practice Standards to the College on completion of the same.
4. The Clinical Records Audit will be conducted by an auditor appointed by the College at a cost of \$500 to the Respondent.
